In addition, to these programs and services, the Women's Outreach coordinates the Tools for School program which distributes backpacks to help children return to school with appropriate school supplies, and the Adopt A Family program assisting single parents who are unable to provide a Christmas for their children. 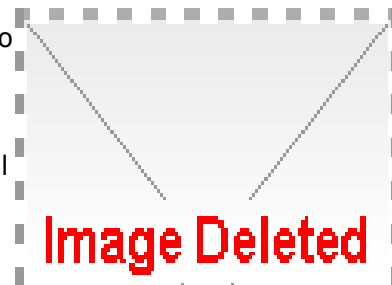
It is because of your support and generosity that our programs and services are successful.

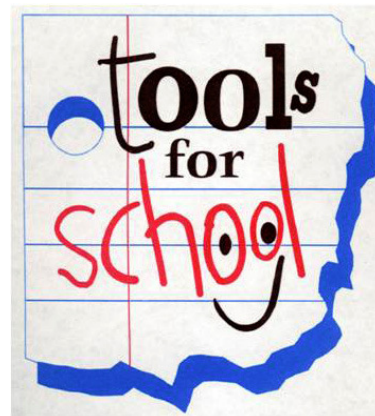
